Risk Level Indicators:

Risk Level 1 (Low Risk):

- **No Frankfurt Rhein/Main community cases of swine flu**
- Very few reported cases of swine flu in Germany
- Some countries declare public health emergency
- Airports implement informal screening mechanisms

Risk Level 2 (Moderate Risk):

- **Limited number of swine flu cases in Frankfurt Rhein/Main community (no FIS/ISW cases)**
- Travel advisories recommended by WHO, CDC, government authorities
- No FIS/ISW students, families, faculty or staff identified with swine flu
- Average student attendance remains high, 90-100%
- Swine flu virus behavior / contagiousness remains unchanged
- No advisories against non-essential travel to Frankfurt and Wiesbaden
- WHO and regional health authorities declare pandemic

Risk Level 3 (Medium Risk)

- **Few swine flu cases within FIS/ISW community**
- Increased community spread of swine flu in Frankfurt Rhein/Main area
- Average student attendance below 80 – 90%
- Increasing evidence of potential restrictions on airline travel / other forms of international public transportation
- Swine flu disease behavior / contagiousness changes to higher risk level

Risk Level 4 (High Risk)

- **Spread of swine flu within the FIS/ISW community rapidly increasing**
- Swine flu cases quickly increasing in Frankfurt Rhein/Main area
- Government directs that schools be closed
- Evidence that hospitals are unable to manage or meet health care needs related to swine flu
- Evidence of restricted airline travel or major travel restrictions
- Staffing and attendance issues at FIS/ISW
